*Manager, Tu Kōtahi Māori Asthma and Research Trust*

Cheryl Davies (Ngāti WehiWehi/Ngāti Mutunga o Wharekauri) is the Manager of Tu Kōtahi Māori Asthma and Research Trust and is a senior Kaupapa Māori researcher. For over two decades, Cheryl has worked in transformative research partnering with Māori communities. Cheryl was instrumental in the development of the Kaupapa Māori framework 'Whānau Tuatahi' which facilitates community–researcher partnerships to give voice to whānau wellbeing aspirations.

Cheryl will discuss the establishment of the newly formed Palliative Care Aotearoa Research Network (PCARN). PCARN is working to create a network of clinical palliative care researchers in Aotearoa to help link existing researchers with those early career researchers. PCARN will offer mentorship to new and existing researchers by assisting with the generation of research ideas and providing advice and resources. We have a key objective to support early Māori researchers and promote opportunities for Māori community researchers to lead and be involved in our mahi.
